Dear Clients, Partners and Friends,

We are pleased to update you on the current situation in Iraq as follows:

#### 1. Latest News

- ► Independence vote at Kurdish Regional Government and its impacts on the region On Sep 25<sup>th</sup> people in the KRG controlled areas got the possibility to vote if KRG shall remain a part of Iraq or if KRG shall become an independent state. As per latest news approx. 93% of them have voted for independence. Local politicians at KRG have welcomed those results. But their political neighbors have asked KRG not to take further steps towards independence. Central Iraqi Government as well as Iran and Turkey have informed that economic and political sanctions might be the consequence.
- Central Iraqi Government has asked KRG to hand over the control and administration of Ibrahim Khalil and Hajj Omran border gates as well as Erbil Airport and Sulaymaniyah Airport.
- This request has been rejected by KRG.
- As a consequence Iraqi
   Government has arranged that flights to Erbil and

- Sulaymaniyah Airport will be stopped from Sep 29<sup>th</sup>18.00 h until further notice.
- Iran has announced that no flights from and to KRG will be operated via Iranian airspace.
- Turkey has blocked cargo movements from KRG region to Turkey and to other countries via turkish seaports until further notice.
- KRG has sent delegations to Baghdad, Teheran and Ankara and is currently searching for a suitable and acceptable solution for the region.
- German Ministry of Foreign
   Affairs has set a travel warning
   for its citizens and advised
   them to keep out of risky and
   unstable areas.

We are monitoring the situation daily and will keep you closely updated. In case of any question please feel free to contact our team which will be ready and glad to assist.

New regulation for shipments to Kurdistan Regional
Government of Iraq
The Quality Department at KRG has signed an agreement with the inspection company Intertek.

Intertek has taken over the border inspection at the Kurdish entry points of Iraq. Furthermore Intertek has been authorized to inspect shipments at the countries of export if they are listed on the commonly prepared list and shall issue a certificate of conformity for those shipments. As per now only cargo with final destination Kurdistan Regional Government is affected by this new regulation. For more detailed information please get in contact with our team. ## ► <u>Current and upcoming</u> Roadblocks

While the current roadblocks for cargo movements due to Ashura period are expected to be lifted on Oct 5<sup>th</sup> the next roadblocks due to Zeyarah Arbaeeniyah period are expected between Oct 26<sup>th</sup> and Nov 17<sup>th</sup>. Once the official dates are available we will provide them immediately.

## 2. Security Situation

#### Iraq

Several attacks have been registered in Baghdad area and in Nasiriya in the last days and weeks. Especially pilgrims were the aim of those attacks. They were on the way to the holy sites which are usually visited during Ashura period. The authorities have tightened the security measures and deployed the troops to strategically important areas.

#### 3. Border situation

### Turkish/Iraqi border

The security situation is currently stable. Turkish and Iraqi Army launched military maneuvers near Habur border gate in Silopi on 23 Sep which are still ongoing. Border gate for cargo movements from Turkey to Iraq is open. The waiting times are around 2-4 days and might increase the next days. Furthermore the border gate might be closed fully for a certain time period. Cargo movements from Iraq to Turkey are currently not possible because this part of the border is closed. We will keep monitoring the border situation and keep you closely updated.

## ► Jordanian/Iragi border

The border gates are opened and cargo traffic is allowed again. Presently only a few companies are using this route. Jordanian government announced that they will not charge Iraqi trucks with parking fees on the Jordanian side of the border in order to promote the trade between both countries.

► Saudi Arabian-Iraqi border
Saudi Arabia and Iraq have
reopened the border crossing
Arar for trade after 27 years.
Both countries have deployed
troops to protect the border
point with utmost care. As per
now no obstacles are registered.

### 4. Airfreight

Erbil/Sulaymaniyah Airport
As per announcement of the
Central Iraqi Government
international flights from and to
Erbil and Sulaymaniyah Airport
will be stopped from Sep 29<sup>th</sup> –
18.00 h until further notice.

Baghdad/Basrah Airport
Due to Ashura period between
Sep 15<sup>th</sup> and Oct 5<sup>th</sup> operations
are running on a low level but

generally there are no obstacles registered.

## 5. Oceanfreight

Umm Qassr/Khor Al Zubair Seaport Also here the operations are running on a low level due to Ashura period and no obstacles registered.

Mersin/Iskenderun seaport Port operations are running smoothly and no obstacles are registered.

### 6. Overland Transport

RoRo Ferry Trieste-Mersin and Route via Balkan
Cargo movements via Trieste-Mersin RoRo Ferry are running smoothly and no obstacles are registered.
